How It Works

Teams of 8 will compete against other teams in several rounds of trivia questions. The team with the most points at the end of the night wins! The winning team will receive **major** bragging rights plus a small prize to show off at work on Monday morning.

There will be 6 standard rounds of 10 questions each, all related to the night's theme. Answers will be tallied and posted after each round. One team will be crowned the winner after the 6 rounds.

A bonus 7th round, consisting of 10 questions related to Prairie Crossing Charter School, will give you a second chance at winning a prize.

A third prize will be given to the team with the best table decorations and costumes. Teams are encouraged to participate in this tradition, however it is by no means required. Use the theme and your team name to inspire your costumes and decorations.

This year's theme is: (Trivial) Pursuit of Happiness

Huh? What kind of costume do you wear for that?!? I don't know! **Be creative!**

All funds from Trivia Night go directly to PSO! The PSO raises funds to directly help the teachers, staff and students at PCCS. Funds raised at Trivia Night help fund a variety of programs including teacher reimbursements, grade band grants and the student hardship fund.

How to Register

Fill out the registration form, available below. Turn in the form at the PCCS office, with your registration fee of \$10 per person, by Wednesday, February 8th. If you have a team of 8, or even a partial team, register everyone together on one form. If you do not have a team, don't worry! Individuals and partial teams will be assembled to make full teams on game night. Maybe you'll make some new friends!

What to Bring

This is a social event, so bring food and beverages (adult beverages are allowed) for your team. **Please remember to bring plates, utensils, etc,** and try to make the night as trash free as possible. Do not bring children to the event, however child care services are available at the school (see below).

Child Care

The 8th graders (and some parent volunteers) will be providing child care in the gym to raise money for their trip to Virginia. The cost is:

\$15 for 1 child

\$25 for 2 children

\$35 for 3 children

\$45 for 4 children

No more than \$50 per family

Children must be at least 3 years of age, no diapers. Snacks and juice will be provided, but please feed your children some dinner before you come. Fill out the child care registration form and turn it in by Wednesday, February 8th. Remember to include payment with the form. All kids must be registered by February 8th so we can make sure there are enough volunteers.
