

Spelling Sorts

We will have spelling each day and homework every night. At the end of each week students will take their assessment.

New Sort: The students are introduced to their sort. They cut the words out and sort them on their desks. Once the sort is checked they should neatly write it in their word work journal.

Sentences: Students write a sentence for each sort word.

Speed Sort: A speed sort is when students sort their words into the correct categories as quickly as they can. They should repeat this 3 times and record their time in their word work journals.

Buddy Sort: The students do this in class and take turns doing their sorts with a buddy.

Write Sort: Students write their words in the correct categories practicing spelling and neat handwriting.

Blind Sort: The students verbally say or point to the correct sort category.

Blind-Write Sort: Parents call out the sort words to the student and the student writes them in the correct category.

Word Hunt: Students practice finding words that fit into their sort categories in books or magazines.

Assessment: Students take their assessment
