1. Accelerated Differentiation:

T. Zamiar and K. Smith presented background information regarding selection of program. ALEKS versus Redbird. ALEKS selected as "best fit for PCCS". A webbased program, ALEKS will provide individualized math instruction for targeted 5-8 students. This will be a "blended approach" along with Connected Mathematics Project 3 curriculum.

Discussion regarding how staff would be trained (online staff development via ALEKS), targeted students (teacher-selected), and scaffolding (ALEKS system selects/monitors progress based upon modules).

T. Zamiar also shared that High School feeder schools are being asked for specific course requirements (i.e., 8^{th} grade regular math, Algebra) as part of 8^{th} /HS transition and placement.

2. PARCC Results:

T. Zamiar shared document reflecting PCCS Global PARCC results. Document showed overall school composite, and breakdown of ELA/Math subtests for grade levels 3-8. General trends discussed. Composite ELA: Vocabulary a relative strength, composite Math: Math Major Content shows room for improvement
