Academic Excellence

At PCCS, we pride ourselves on teaching the whole child. What this means is that we devote much of our time and resources to building social-emotional skills, environmental awareness, and stewardship among our students.

This week, however, I want to focus just a little on our academic growth goals and success. Our goal every year is for all of our students to show at least one year of growth as measured by the different assessments and benchmarks throughout the school year. Our teachers are constantly looking at data from these assessments in order to discern what strategies and materials to best use to continue the growth patterns and reach these goals.

We are proud again this year to announce our continued success on the PARCC test, which measures our students' success as compared to the Illinois Learning Standards. On October 31st, 2016, the State will release those results using the Illinois Report Card. We invite you to attend the November School Board meeting, where we will deliver an analysis of those results. Finally, we will continue to use those data to build continuous progress for all of our students. Last month, we sent home PARCC results from last spring's test. Please reference that test to see your child's specific growth. Thank you for partnering with us as we work for every student's academic success!
