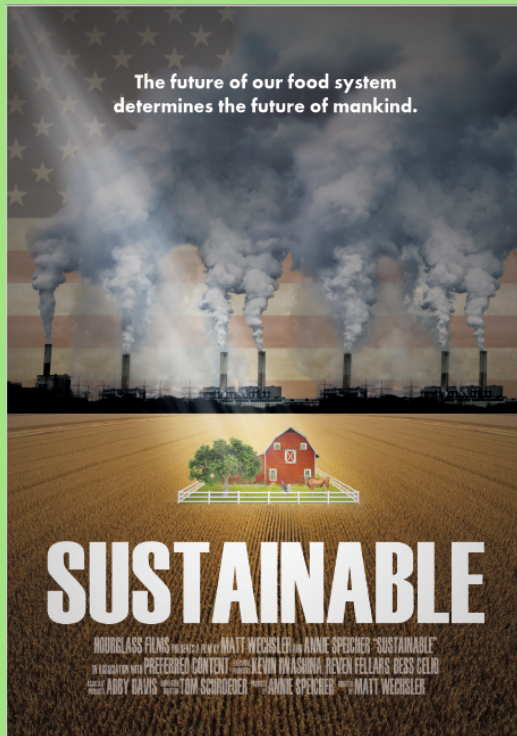


2017 Food & Farming Film Series

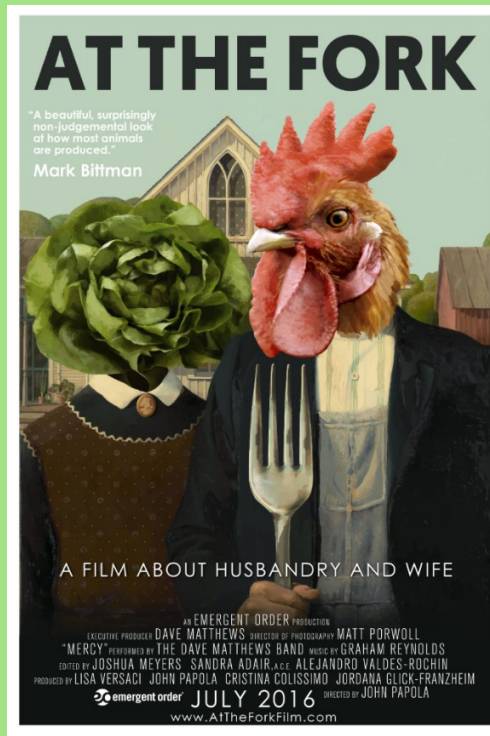


Wednesday, January 11 at 7:00pm
