BE A MENTOR. START SOMETHING.

A new neighborhood-based mentoring program is starting up this winter/spring in Warren Township.

The mentoring program, facilitated by **Big Brothers Big Sisters**, will take place 2 times per month from 6-7:30 pm at the **Gurnee Teen Center***.

Mentors will be matched with a student in grades 5-7 of the same gender. Activities will be pre-planned by an experienced facilitator and will take place in groups.

Each 90 minutes session will include time for homework, relationship building, group activity and free time, all based around themes like educational achievement, avoiding risky behaviors, building confidence and appropriate social skills.

Mentor Requirements

- Be at least 18 years old
- Be able to attend the entire program meetings for a minimum of 1 year.
- Be able to participate in regular phone contacts with a Big Brothers Big Sisters staff person.
- Volunteers provide their own transportation to and from the program meetings.
- Be willing to pay a one-time application fee of \$35**
