- Full day preschool for 4 years and up
- Multi-day and week long class options

Growing Tree Preschool offers programming at two different facilities to better serve the Gurnee community. Programs are located inside Viking Park Community Center and Hunt Club Park Community Center.

Each facility has a large room for gross motor activities in case of inclement weather, preschool events and graduation ceremonies.

designed for preschool age children are for the exclusive use of our students during preschool hours creating a fun and safe environment for gross motor activities. Each fenced playground provides a wide variety of age-appropriate equipment, a sand feature and grassy areas for expanded play.



Special Events

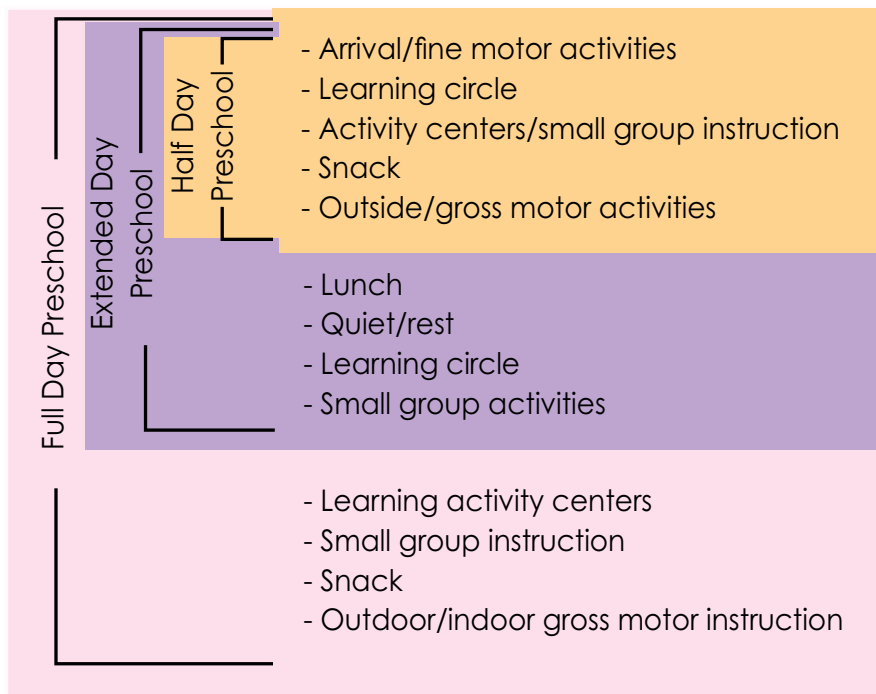
Throughout the school year a variety of events are held for children and their families:

Our preschool class options



2.5 year preschool

This preschool class for our youngest students provides an opportunity to separate from parents, learn the routine of preschool, socialize and interact with peers, gain confidence and be ready for the full Growing Tree Preschool curriculum next year. Toilet training is not required. Pull-ups are permissible but staff does not change children during class time.



3 year preschool

Fun and learning in a nurturing environment promotes a positive adjustment to school, encourages social development and provides an ideal initial experience with our kindergarten readiness curriculum.



4 year extended day preschool

These classes provide an excellent opportunity for children who are ready for a longer day to prepare for full-day kindergarten. The curriculum focus is on social, academic and kindergarten readiness skills, with expanded learning in areas such as math, science and language arts. Children bring a peanut/nut free lunch and eat at school.

4 year Pre-K preschool

The focus is getting ready for kindergarten in a fun, social and academic environment with emphasis on mastering readiness skills as children progress through our curriculum. Childcare (CARE) before and after preschool is also available as indicated on the next page.



4-5 year Pre-K preschool

Children will learn, grow and prepare for full day kindergarten in this dynamic class filled with an extensive kindergarten-readiness curriculum based on the State of Illinois Early Learning Standards for preschool which include: social/emotional skills, language arts, math, sciences, fine arts, foreign language, physical development and health. Plus this full day curriculum also includes expanded foreign language, pre-reading skills, art, music, daily physical fitness inside or outdoors, and an opportunity to utilize the most current technology. Children enrolled in the five day option have weekly Spanish and yoga instruction. All Children bring a lunch each day.



Preschool CARE

Parents who work or need extra time can be assured their child enrolled in the Growing Tree Preschool will have fun with supervised play, crafts, games and outdoor activities. Children bring the appropriate outerwear each day so we can use our outdoor parks and facilities. Staff will escort children to/from their preschool class. This program is not in session on school days off. A school calendar will be provided at the beginning of the school year. For an additional fee, a separate program will be held on most school days off. Please visit GurneeParkDistrict.com for the CARE payment and refund policy.

Summer Sprouts provides young children an opportunity to experience the routine of preschool, play and interact with peers, gain confidence and most of all, have fun! Children are strongly encouraged to register for multiple sessions which helps children with separation concerns, as well as learning routines. Pull-ups are permissible, but staff does not change children during class. Toilet Training is not required. **You may pay in full or pay a non-refundable \$50 deposit per child, per session.** (SH)

- Tuition payments are non-refundable, non-transferable and may not be pro-rated
- Tuition is based on the total number of days in the school year divided into nine equal installments

- Accommodations for special needs students available

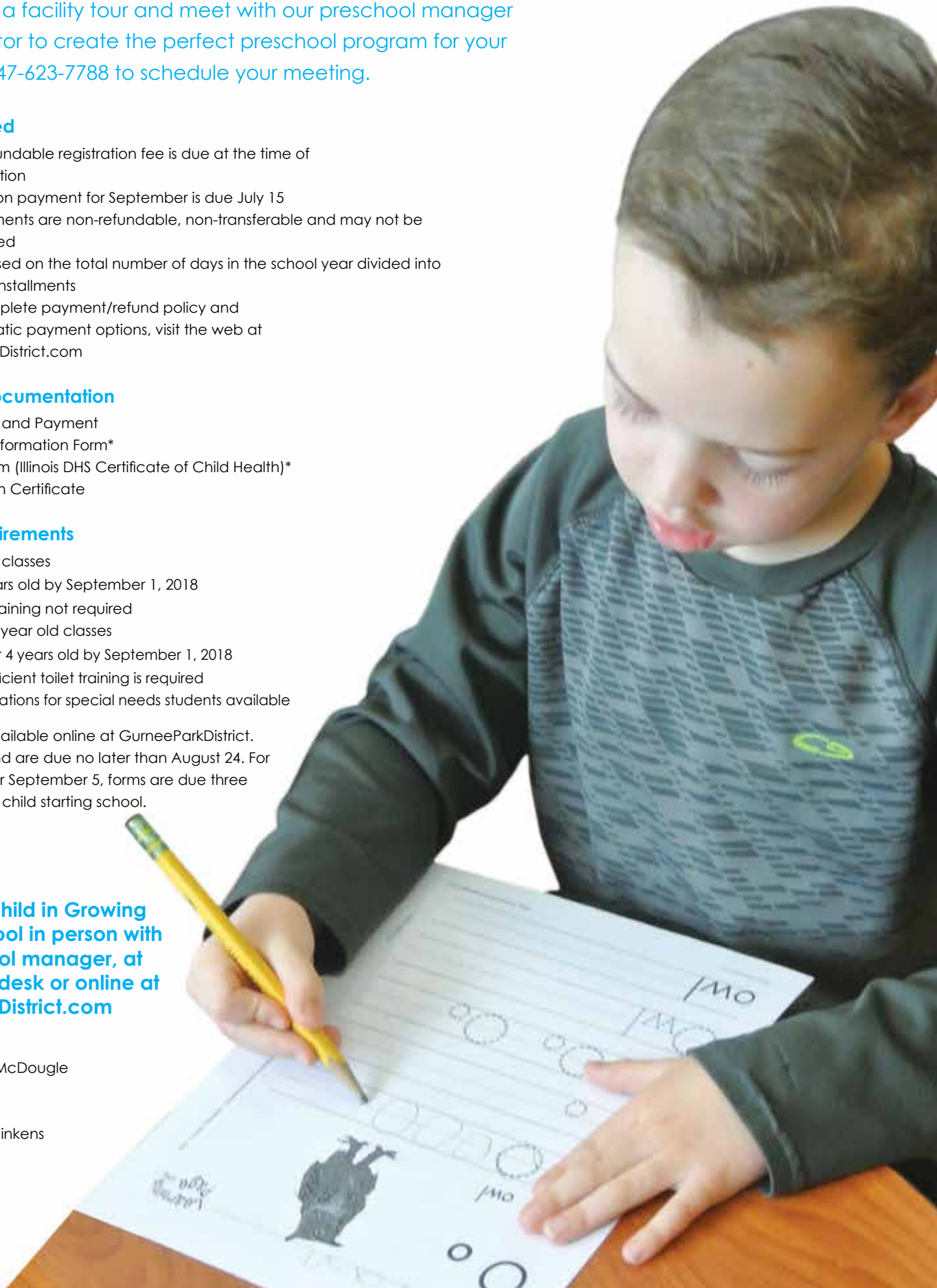
*Forms will be available online at GurneeParkDistrict.com mid-July and are due no later than August 24. For registrations after September 5, forms are due three days prior to the child starting school.
