Reading:

The students have been working very hard on their Little House on the Prairie readings. This week we are going to be completing chapters 4-6 and having many discussions as the students answer vocabulary and comprehension questions. They will also be comparing and contrasting and summarizing. We are also going to be learning about drama, poetry, and prose for the next two weeks.

Writing:

Students are making corrections and peer editing their persuasive pieces. We will be sharing these with a third grade class next week! They are also working on publishing "Fun Write" pieces, which include cliffhanger stories that they are finishing using a variety of techniques they have been learning.

Sci/SS

We are finishing our rock/mineral, landform, and soil unit this week. Students will be learning more about the rock cycle, minerals, and layers of the earth this week.

MATH

This week, students will extend their work with angles and explore attributes of polygons and measuring angles with a protractor. Students will be introduced to lines of symmetry and they will work to define and create examples of polygons with one or more lines of symmetry. Then students will be reviewing different types of triangles, quadrilaterals, and other polygons as they create a set of polygon cards that they will use to help solve a collection of riddles. There will be home connections and IXL standards assigned throughout the week.
