Reading:

This week we are going to be reviewing many skills we have learned this year including cause and effect, sequencing, main idea and detail, point of view, inferencing, and storyline/plot summarizing. We will also be reading nonfiction about weather.

Writing:

Students are continuing to write their end of year samples for persuasive and narrative writing. Many students are also working towards publishing and sharing their “fun write” narratives that they have been working on throughout the year.

Sci/SS:

This week students are finishing and sharing their weather projects. On Thursday we will be at the Grove in Glenview for our field trip. The Grove houses the original home to the Kennicott family as they settled in the area in the 1850s. Hands-on colonial experiences such as learning in a one room schoolhouse, performing pioneer chores and games, and constructing log cabins are some of the highlights for the all-day field trip.

Math

Students will go through their final unit tests and make corrections. I am very proud of how they did! We will continue with math for the remainder of this year working on skills they have developed over the course of the year. This includes multiplication, division, unit conversions, area/perimeter, fractions, decimals, and more. Students will also be working with a real world garden bed area and perimeter problem outside in our garden beds. Students briefly worked with graphing data during the science project and we will practice this skill as well.
