Diwali at PCCS!

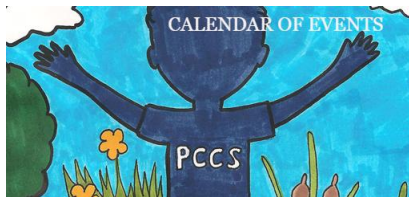
Mr. Freeman, our EL teacher, is planning a Diwali presentation for October. Please **contact him** if you want to help plan this culturally enriching event!
