Sight Word Activities

For each activity, you can also have your child write the words. Or you write the word and then have them copy your word on their own card. They can also trace your writing.

Sight word hide and seek - Write all the sight words on individual cards and have your child hide them around the house. When you find the card, read it to your child. Then trade and you hide the cards, having your child find them and read the word to you.

Sight word memory game - Write each sight word on two cards. Then place all the cards face down and take turns turning over two cards at a time. If the sight words match, then you have a pair. Keep going until all the pairs are made. Practice reading the words as you turn the cards over. The player with the most pairs is the winner!

Sight word tickets - Write sight words on individual cards. Make fun reasons for them to read you a sight word ticket. For example, before dinner, you can have them put a ticket at each person's chair. When the person sits down, they read their sight word as a meal ticket.

Sight word signs - Post sight words around the house for them to read as they pass from room to room. It could become a fun game of **Follow the Leader** as well: The leader hops, crawls, etc, around the room, saying the sight word as they pass by it. The followers have to do the same actions, reading the sight words as they go.
