**Reading**

This week in reading we will be continuing our Little House on the Prairie reading and reading in small groups. We will work with cause and effect, summarizing, and accurately answering a variety of comprehension questions. We will also be reading about some monumental people to celebrate black history month.

**Writing**

**Science**

We are continuing our experiments on soil and landforms, with an emphasis this week on erosion and deposition.

**MATH**

They will describe, analyze, compare and classify circles, radii, diameters, and circumferences with partners and independently.
