STEMgirls Camp Frequently Asked Questions

- How do I enroll my child in the program?
Complete the front and back of this form. Drop off or mail all completed forms and a registration fee to the following address: iBIO Institute c/o Industrious 171 N. Aberdeen Street, Suite 400 Chicago, IL 60607.
- Will I receive a refund if my child is unable to attend?
You will receive a complete refund if you cancel your child/ren's registration by 4 p.m. on Friday, May 17, 2019.
- What is the general schedule for camp?
*Early Drop off is 8 – 9 a.m.
Drop off is 9 a.m.
Activities run 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.
Pick up is at 3 p.m.
Late Pick up is from 3 – 4 p.m.*
- Where do I drop off and pick up my child?
This year's STEMgirls Camp is located at Cristo Rey St. Martin College Prep 3106 Belvidere Rd., Waukegan, IL 60085. Drop off and pick up will be located right inside the main entrance.
- Can my child sign herself in and out?
Your camper may sign herself in and out each day as long as your camper is over 10 years old and you send a note prior to the first day of camp (either by mail or e-mail). Please notify us if your camper is able to leave the premises after signing out. If not, we will make sure an adult from the pick up list is present before signing out.
- Where is the camp field trip this year?
*The campers will travel by bus to attend a field trip at the Lake County Forest Preserve district at the Wright Woods Pond. Groups 3 & 4 will leave on Tuesday, 6/18. Groups 1 & 2 will leave on Wednesday, 6/19. Group 5 will leave on Thursday, 6/20. **Please provide a bag lunch for them that day.***
- Is my camper allowed to be in the same group as her friends?
As listed on the registration form, you may request your child to be grouped with her friends. Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee all requests but we will do our best to accommodate.
- What should children bring to camp every day?
Comfortable clothing in which they can participate in a wide variety of activities is preferred. The campers will be participating in hands-on experiments that may include household items such as: food coloring, markers, chalk, etc. Please make sure that what your child/ren wear is okay to get dirty. Make sure that all your child's belongings are marked with her name. Cell phones are not to be used during camp except in an emergency or to speak with parents/guardians. We would prefer children do not bring any electronic devices but understand the security a cell phone may provide. If this is the case, please advise your child before attending camp of our cell phone policy.
- Can parents/guardians observe my child as the program is in session?
To keep disruptions to a minimum, we ask parents and guardians to wait until Family Day to observe and participate with their child/ren during the program. This year's Family Day is on Friday, June 21, 2019 from 9 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Parents, guardians and community supporters are invited to attend.
- Do you provide transportation to/from camp?

- Is food provided for campers?
*Lunch as well as morning and afternoon snacks are available to the campers. **Please note:** lunch will not be provided during the field trip. Please bring a bag lunch.*
- What if there is an emergency and I can't pick up my child by 3:00 p.m.?
We understand that problems and disruptions sometimes occur during a parent's day that can throw off schedules. However, in order to compensate for camp staff having to stay late, we assess a \$10/quarter hour childcare fee for children picked up after 4 p.m. This amount is due upon late pick-up.
