Our Learning

4th Grade Math: Students learned about volume and capacity and studied metric and customary types of measurement. We used visual models to compare ounces to cups and milliliters. We will continue to build arrays and ratio tables. Please encourage your student to work on their multiplication facts from 0-12.

Reading: Focused reading groups will be learning about Greek Myths, Fables, and Fairytales in preparation for our upcoming Chapter book groups. Please encourage your child to read at home.

Science/Social Studies: In Social Studies, we learned about business start-up costs and financial loans. Students wrote a mock letter for an "Apple Cider" loan and were able to calculate unit costs. We will continue to study economic concepts in the upcoming week.

Writing: Students created fictional characters and wrote short stories about their characters. We are currently learning about personal narratives. We will also continue to work on vocabulary and grammar.
