Our Learning

4th Grade Math: Students will take their Unit 2 Assessment on Monday 10/21. Study guides came home on Friday. We will then begin Unit 3, which will continue multiplication and division strategies, and add fractions. Our first module will cover equivalent fractions.

Reading: Third graders continue to read the novel, *The Chocolate Touch* and fourth graders *The Underworlds* in class. Students also complete corresponding comprehension questions for each chapter.

Science/Social Studies: Students are working in small groups on a "light maze" project. Each group has to reflect light with a flashlight throughout their maze design using 6 mirrors. We have very creative designs being implemented! Then, we will learn about light in relationship to the human eye.

Writing: Students continue to work on their personal narratives and handwriting skills. We begin peer editing this week. Students are also creating realistic fiction stories using a character they developed.
