Math

This week in math students will learn the formal definition of what they have been working with: the array. They will then solve multiplication story problems and generate a list of multiplication strategies that they have been exposed to so far that they can refer to throughout the rest of the unit. Then, they will begin to explore the ratio table, a model and tool that invites them to explore proportional thinking. Toward the end of the week, they will identify and label types of multiplication facts in a Multiplication Table. Much like work with the Addition and Subtraction Tables from Unit 1, categorizing facts helps students begin to internalize these basic combinations.
