News from Mrs. Barnett's Classroom October 4, 2019



Weekly Highlights

Daily 5- This week we introduced Word Work where students work on writing their sight words. They will work on sight words for a week using different word work activities. These activities will help the students commit their sight words to memory. We have introduced all 5 components of Daily 5 and will continue to work on more reading strategies and read with small groups on a daily basis.

Work on Writing- Students worked on writing their stories bit by bit. We broke down their stories into small parts and focused in on emotions and thoughts.

Social Studies- We had a lot of fun on our field trip to LEARN Charter school. Students worked with Learn Charter School students in their classrooms. We took a tour of the school. PCCS students took notes on how the Learn Charter School is like our school and how it is different. We created a venn diagram to show our similarities and our differences.

Science- We continue to observe our mealworms and Brassica plants. The students were amazed at how quickly our plants have sprouted and grown. Students look closely at them and make observations and record them in their Theme notebooks. Our mealworms have been busy growing as well, molting many times. On Friday students observed that some of the larva have changed into the pupa stage.

E.E.- This week we harvested carrots with Ms. Naomi and sent to our solo spots. The students looked for signs of fall while at their solo spots.

Math Highlights

This week we finished up Unit 2 Module 1 and moved into Module 2. Fact Families were a big focus for us this week. The kids made double flap cards with dots, pictures and numbers to help them understand fact families. These lessons focused on applying the commutative property of addition to add, solving subtraction problems by finding an unknown addend and using relationships between addition and subtraction to add and subtract within 10. We continued to review and use the addition strategies that we learned last week.
