Weekly Highlights

Spelling- Students continue to work with their words in their sorts learning different spelling patterns. We have also incorporated Seesaw activities that help reinforce the spelling patterns that they are working with.

Daily 5- This week we focused on identifying characters and setting in stories. Students had fun using Seesaw during work on writing to write about what I should be for Halloween. They continue to work on their sight words for word work and we have incorporated IXL during sessions for students to work on their diagnostic page. More info will come out once they have completed this work.

Writer's Workshop- We are finishing up our personal narrative unit. Students have been editing their stories focusing on fixing up spelling, adding capital letters and punctuation. Next week we will be working on our final drafts, adding an All About the Author page, a cover and a dedication page.

Social Studies/Science- Over the past 2 weeks we have been talking about Natural Resources and that we can get our resources from a local provider or a distant provider. Students identified resources in our classroom and lunch and if we can get them locally or if we need to get them from a distant place.

On Thursday, Ms Naomi came and taught a lesson about the natural community and community helpers within nature. It was a cold and snowy day so we had to stay in for the lesson. The kids enjoyed learning about plant jobs such as air creators, soil makers, soil helpers, homemakers and food makers. We learned about animal jobs such as soil helpers, garbage collectors, carriers, population controllers and soil adders.

On Friday we went out to look for animal tracks in the snow. We found so many tracks! We found squirrel, skunk, rabbit, coyote, dog, horse, vole and bird tracks. It was a lot of fun!

Math Highlights

This week we finished up Unit 3 Module 1- Single Digit Sums. Students were introduced to 3 new workplaces. The first workplace was Drop the Beans. This workplace focused on adding fluently with sums to 10 and using the commutative property. The second workplace was Make the Sum. This workplace focused on applying the commutative and associative properties of addition to add. The third workplace was Doubles Plus 1/Minus 1. This workplace focused on solving addition and subtraction problems by counting on or counting back, doubles facts to 20 and identifying numbers as odd or even. We finished the week off with story problems and using our number racks. Students used the number racks to solve both addition and subtraction story problems to 20. **Math Vocabulary**- add, addition, double, half, even, odd, subtract, subtraction, minus, equal, total
