Class Highlights

Theme— The students played a game to review the terms goods and service. They worked with a partner to determine if they received a good or service from the person listed on the card. For example, a dentist, a butcher, or a hairdresser. On Thursday, Ms. Naomi came to teach about producers/consumers, goods/services in Nature! The next lesson had them writing an I wonder statement about salsa—what does it take to make, what are the steps needed to take? They did a great job!

Writing—This week we continued our teaching writing unit by focusing on how-to writing. Students will write a how-to piece about making a snowman. 2ND GRADE MATH

We continued our measurement lessons! This week we used a yardstick to measure various items around the classroom. Students learned why using a large measuring tool is good when having to measure large objects! Several new Work Places were introduced this week. Students are measuring 2 objects, finding the difference, and then repeating this twice. They add up the differences and compare with their partner. Another one has them adding up dice (#5-9), and then subtracting 9 or 10 from that number. Their goal is to climb the bean-stalk.
