What we did this week:

- All reading assessments have been finished! Students will have new reading groups after break.
- A Spelling assessment was given this last Tuesday. Students will be getting new Spelling groups and sorts when they get back from break.
- We took a break from our usual Nonfiction teaching books and did a "How to Build a Snowman" paper. Students made a snowman, fit it inside a globe, and then wrote about how they made their picture step-by-step. Ask your student how to make a snowman!
- In Social Studies we reviewed goods and services, discussed a little bit about the
 food chain, and then went into a discussion about how income works. Students
 learned what income is and gave me examples of how they earn money at home.
 We then went deeper and talked about how people spend money, how you can
 save money, and how people share money.
- In Math we continued to measure objects around the classroom. We also referenced back to the *Jim and the Beanstalk* book several times throughout the week. Students looked at a picture of what the giant's door looks like and compared the different objects outside the door (kids, dog, and gardening tools). Students had to compare the sizes of the different objects (i.e. 1 kid was the size of 1 brick, 2 envelopes were the size of 1 hammer, etc.). After break we will take the Unit 4 assessments and finish off the rest of Unit 4's lessons.
