What we did this week:

- On Monday we took the Pre-Assessment for our new math unit on measuring.
 Pre-assessments are used to show students what the unit will be about and to show the teacher what the students already know. We read the book <u>Jim and the Beanstalk</u> which talks about measuring different objects using a measuring tape. The class was able to use "teacher feet", "giant feet", and tiles to measure different objects in our classroom. On Thursday, students made their own inchworm rulers (ask your student about these) and were able to use those to help measure as well.
- We have been working on our Nonfiction writing books during writing. Students were able to add more details, and then later in the week students used checklists to evaluate their writing pieces. They were able to see what details they had in their writing and what they were missing. Ask your student what they are writing their teaching books about! On Friday we focused on spelling, capitals, and punctuation. Ms. Jensen and I worked with groups throughout Writing to focus on these areas.
- In Social Studies we started discussing consumers and producers. Students
 have become pretty familiar with these two new vocabulary words. Ask them
 what they mean and to give an example of each!
- Reading groups have been put on hold as I am administering reading assessments for new reading groups after Winter Break. Students continue to work on writing, word work, and reading during Daily 5.
