### Class Highlights

**Theme**— We started our new PBL Unit. We will focus on economics. This week students learned about Producers and Consumers. This included watching two short clips, taking a short quiz (as a whole class), reading two great books, and writing down examples. Students realized that someone could be both a producer and a consumer.

**Writing**—This week students compared illustrations/pictures in nonfiction vs. fiction text. They found out that the pictures in nonfiction text are full of information. They worked on adding information to their pictures with zoom-in pictures.

**Daily 5**—Reading Groups changed a little bit this week. We continued to focus on comprehension. Students are asked various types of questions—both those that can be answered in the book and some that make them think beyond the text.

#### 2ND GRADE MATH

Unit 4 is up and running! This unit has the students focused on measurement. Please check out the family letter to get a great overview of the unit.

Students have worked on estimating lengths and then using a tool to measure—we have used teacher feet, giant feet, and head string to measure various lengths. Thursday, the students made an inchworm ruler to use as a tool to measure various objects around the classroom. We have focused on how to correctly measure an object—start at one end, and no gaps!
