Weekly Highlights

Writing- This week we started writing chapter books. Students chose topics that they are experts on and came up with titles of chapter to work on. Some students started their chapter books.

Spelling/Daily 5- Students continued to work on spelling sorts throughout the week. We worked on inferring during Daily 5 and students demonstrated their understanding using Seesaw. Students looked at a picture and described what happened. They used their background knowledge to help them infer what happened in the story.

Social Studies- This week we discussed the terms **needs**, **wants**, **saving and spending**. We listened to a couple of books that focused on the difference between needs and wants. We talked about how we can earn money and how do we get things that we need.Students identified ways to save and spend money. We even talked about charitable giving.

Math Highlights

This week we started our Unit 4 Module 3. Students continued to explore open and closed number lines focusing on skip-jumps along the number line of 5s and 10s. We practiced counting by 10s on and off the decade. This would be a great thing to practice over break. Start counting at 4 and have your child count to 104 by 10s etc. On Thursday we finished the module with our Unit assessment. Students demonstrated their understanding of counting forward and backwards, putting numbers on an open number line, addition and subtraction on a number line and story problems.

Math Vocabulary- skip-jump, open number line, Math Homework- through p 64 and IXL for 10 min
