What we did this week:

- In Writing this week students focused on making an introduction to their teaching books. They learned that an introduction can start with a question, an action, a little story that pulls the reader in, or a big idea about the topic. Students also reviewed that sometimes you need to put yourself in the reader's shoes in order to make edits and make their writing even stronger.
- We worked together as a class in Math on counting craft sticks and unifix cubes to see if we had 1,000 of each. Students made predictions before counting each time and worked with their table groups on making groups of 10s and 100s so the counting is easier. We found out that we had 1,105 craft sticks in one box and 978 unifix cubes. I challenged the students to see how many unifix cubes we were missing since they came in 1,000 when the cubes first came to school. On Thursday we took a three-digit number checkpoint as well as a coin pre-test.
- We continued our Economics Unit in Social Studies. The class brainstormed ideas on what we should do with the beans we harvested partway through the year. We continued to discuss spending and saving money.
- This week we did AimsWeb assessing. On Tuesday students were assessed on their Reading skills while on Friday students were assessed on their Math skills.
