NWEA make-ups:

Students needing to complete reading and math will do so this week.

Math:

4th graders are learning about angles using shapes. Students learned new vocabulary terms such as acute, right, and obtuse angles. This week, we will learn how to use a protractor to determine angle amounts in degrees.

Daily 5:
