Reading:

This week in reading, students will be completing an inferencing detective activity and practice reading between the lines. In small groups, students will be reading fictional passages this week and answering a variety of questions about it.

Writing:

Our author is visiting this week and students are exploring their setting in their "Midas touch" inspired stories. Students are breaking down their writing "scene by scene" and describing different settings throughout their story using descriptive imagery.

Sci/SS:

This week students will be focused on the proper way to put together and draw electric circuits. Additionally, they will be reading and acquiring new related vocabulary.

Math

This week students will compare and order unit fractions from greatest to least, first using the paper rectangles they folded and labeled last week. As they discuss their work, students will be guided toward the generalization that the larger the number of people sharing something, the smaller the share. This is established after the "paper cookies" are ordered, and it is tested in a variety of scenarios. Students will then begin to explore ordering fractions on a number line.
