

PCCS Supply List 2020-2021 Seventh/Eighth Grade

Please **LABEL** these items:

- 1 Clear Storage Container (5 Gallon with lid) to organize all student materials at desk
- 5 single-subject spiral notebooks, college-ruled: 1 for SS (yellow), 1 for science (green), 1 for math (blue)(Algebra 1 students will be asked to have a 2" binder as well.), 1 for Spanish (red), 1 for ELA (purple)
- 5 two-pocket folders (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 purple)
- 24 #2 pencils (mechanical or regular)
- 12 ballpoint pens, black or blue
- 4 highlighters, assorted colors
- 1 pack ultra-fine-point Sharpies (5-count black)
- 1 large eraser
- 1 set of earbuds/headphones to stay at school
- 1 calculator
 - 7th grade math: Scientific calculator (TI-30x or similar) or graphing calculator
 - 8th grade math: Scientific calculator (TI-30x or similar) or graphing calculator
 - Algebra: graphing calculator TI-84 or similar
(Students will need a graphing calculator for high school; it may be a good idea to purchase one in 7th grade)
- For geometry: mathematical compass

These items should be kept in a **LABELED** gallon-size ziploc bag or pencil box:

- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of markers, fine or broad line
- 3-pack of glue sticks

- 1 package of Post-It Notes, 3"x3"
- Boys: 1 bottle of hand sanitizer, 1 box of quart-size ziploc bags
- Girls: 1 container of Clorox wipes, 1 box of gallon-size ziploc bags
- 2 boxes of facial tissue
- 1 four-pack of Expo markers, color or black
- FOR ART 8th Grade:** 2 packs of ultra-fine-point Sharpies, black, 5 count
- FOR ART 7th Grade:** 2 packs of ultra-fine-point Sharpies, black, 5 count

Other **OPTIONAL** items: (Please **LABEL**)

- 1 lunch box with REUSABLE (plastic/metal/cloth/glass) containers & a cloth napkin (please label containers)
- 1 REUSABLE water bottle - to be kept at school
- 1 12" ruler, clear safety, standard/metric
- 1 pair of gym shoes (please NO DARK SOLES) - to be kept at school
- 1 VOX Compact Spanish & English Dictionary, 3rd Edition, McGraw Hill or any Spanish dictionary if you can't find the VOX!
