Dear PCCS Community,

We have been receiving inquiries regarding traveling over Spring Break. This message helps clarify PCCS's position on doing so.

As a reminder, the School will not mandate, nor prescribe to parents how to operate their families. The best we can do is inform, educate, and count on people to make the best decisions for themselves and their community outside of school.

We will not be mandating remote learning for all students after Spring Break. Our staff will be fully equipped to accept Group A students on Monday March 29th and Group B students on Thursday April 1st.

The Lake County Health Department continues to recommend avoiding all non-essential travel to limit the spread of COVID-19. If you do travel, remember to:

- Wear a mask.
- Wash your hands.
- Watch your distance.

If you did not follow the 3 Ws while you were traveling, we encourage a 10-day quarantine with your child remote learning during that period. If you choose to do so, please contact your child's teacher informing them of that decision.

If you are planning to travel internationally, be aware that before being allowed to return to the United States, you will need to show proof that you don't have COVID-19. The CDC requires all air passengers arriving in the United States to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test administered within three days of when their flight departs, or to show proof of recovery from COVID-19.
