Dear PCCS Community,

As you may have heard over the break, the CDC has revised their [guidelines for quarantine durations](#).

At PCCS, until we are advised by the Illinois State Board of Education and/or the local authorities, **PCCS will remain in the same protocols as we were prior to Winter Break**.

The State has not changed their status on in person learning, so the option of learning remotely (without being under quarantine protocols) is not available at this time. If you choose to keep your child at home as a precautionary measure, please follow the reporting absences procedures so we can relay that information to the classrooms.

The school will be on a heightened awareness and will be strictly following our mitigation procedures to keep PCCS as safe as possible. We ask that you do the same, if your child is showing signs of any symptoms, please keep them home and follow the flow charts in the reporting absences link above:

We expect that ISBE and the IDPH will provide further updates and if any of the above changes we will certainly share that information with you.
