SUBJECT: REDUCED QUARANTINE TIME EXCEPTIONS
DATE: JANUARY 20, 2022

Dear PCCS Community,

This message serves to inform our community of a few modifications that are taking place at PCCS. With the updated guidance from ISBE/IDPH addressing reduced quarantine times, please note the following exceptions to the return for a close contact or positive case of COVID-19 on Day 6.

Between Days 6-10:

1. The student/staff must wear a mask at all times both indoors and outside.
2. The student/staff will not be able to participate in Band or other extracurricular activities (i.e. sports) until Day 11.
3. Lunch/snack for those who are on the reduced time frame must be socially distanced.
4. Any student/staff that is returning on the reduced timeframe will be eating lunch in an alternative location with at least 6 feet of space between themselves and the next individual. This may mean that your child will need to go to a separate location on campus for the duration of their mealtime.

These exceptions are not exclusive to PCCS and if you are uncomfortable or feel your child is unable to manage these expectations, then the best course of action may be to keep your student home for the entire 10-day period.

No matter which pathway is chosen for returning to on campus learning, on Day 11, they will be able to go back to their pre-quarantine or pre-isolation masking and activities.
